Note 1—Basis of presentation

The accompanying Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards and Supplemental Schedule of Governmental, Restricted Accounts by Agency (the "Schedules") include the federal award activity of the University of Georgia Research Foundation, Inc. ("Foundation") under programs of the federal government for the year ended June 30, 2016. The information in these Schedules is presented in accordance with the requirements of Title 2 U.S. Code of Federal Regulations Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards ("Uniform Guidance"). Because the Schedules present only a selected portion of the operations of the University of Georgia, they are not intended to and do not present either the financial position, changes in net assets, or cash flows of the Foundation.

Note 2—Summary of significant accounting policies

Expenditures reported on the Schedules are prepared on the cash basis of accounting. Such expenditures are recognized following, as applicable, either the cost principles contained in OMB Circular A-21, Cost Principles for Education Institutions, or the cost principles contained in the Uniform Guidance, wherein certain types of expenditures are not allowable or are limited as to reimbursement. Negative amounts shown on the Schedules represent adjustments or credits made in the normal course of business to amounts reported as expenditures in prior years. Pass-through entity identifying numbers are presented where available.

Note 3—Indirect cost rate

The Foundation has elected not to use the 10% de minimis indirect cost rate allowed under Uniform Guidance.

Note 4—Non-cash awards

The Foundation did not receive any non-cash federal awards during the year ended June 30, 2016.

Note 5—Contingencies

These award programs are subject to financial and compliance audits by grantor agencies. The amount, if any, of expenditures that may be disallowed by the grantor agencies cannot be determined at this time, although the Foundation expects such amounts, if any, to be immaterial.

Note 6—State funds

The State of Georgia receives awards directly from the federal government and supplements those funds with its own funds. The State then awards a combination of federal and state funds to the Foundation. If the Foundation is unable to determine the federal portion, the entire amount is reported on the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards.

Note 7—Subrecipient

The Foundation provided all federal awards to the University of Georgia as a sub-recipient.
